On February 7, 2022 came the respondent, by counsel, and filed a motion for “leave to file a supplemental brief and exhibits in support thereof, and for any other relief deemed appropriate by the Court in its discretion.”


Upon consideration whereof, and having afforded the petitioner the requisite ten days to file a response to the motion, which time to file a response expired on February 17, 2022, *see* Rule 5A:2(a)(2), the Court today hereby grants leave to the respondent until February 28, 2022 to file a supplemental response, with supporting exhibits, to the petition for a writ of actual innocence previously filed in this case.

Upon further consideration whereof, and consistent with Rule 5A:5(b)(8), the petitioner may file a reply to the respondent’s supplemental response within thirty (30) days after the said response is filed with this Court.

Accordingly, as it is important for the parties to fully present all of their pleadings, arguments, and exhibits before the Court, oral argument of this matter hereby is continued. However, given the importance of expediting this matter, the parties are encouraged to file their respective pleadings earlier than the deadlines noted herein and, indeed, as soon as possible, so that the Court may reschedule oral argument forthwith in this case.
